A Historical Scenario and A Brief Sketch of the Present Syro Malabar Church in Ireland for a Better Vision Towards Future

INTRODUCTION

The Syro Malabar Church, traces its origin to the preaching of the gospel by St. Thomas, the Apostle of Jesus Christ in AD 52. Kodungalloor is the cradle of Christian faith in India. He founded 7 Churches, (Communities of Faith) viz., Niranam, Palayur, Korkkangalam, Nilackal, Kottakavu, Kollam and Kodungalloor. The journey of this Church was not so easy as we think. Lot of trials and tribulations had to be endured and confronted in its march for present situation.

The institution of new Apostolic Vicariates Trichur and Kottayam on 20 May 1887, paved the way for the gradual development of the Syro Malabar Church. Later in 1923 Syro Malabar Hierarchy was formed. The Syro Malabar Church was raised to the status of a Major Archiepiscopal sui iuris Church on December 16, 1992. Gratefully remember St. Pope John Paul II of Happy Memory, Pope Benedict and Pope Francis for their gentle and generous support to this Apostolic Church.

Gladly acknowledge the laborious endeavours of Mar Abraham Kattumana, Mar Antony Cardinal Padiyara, Mar Varkey Cardinal Vithayathil, Mar George Cardinal Alencherry. Their deep dedication and profound commitment have helped us to reach us to this splendid stage

The Phenomenon of Migration of Syro Malabar Faithful: It was simply incredible, delicate and daring. The early episode of migrations were to the northern part of Kerala and later to the outside of the state of Kerala. They migrated in view of getting better standard of living, obtaining good job and acquiring good education. But they never forgot to carry the memory of God that they have received through the traditions and culture. That is why we have 13 eparchies (dioceses) outside Kerala in India. The development of Syro Malabar Church cannot be limited to this internal migration The international migration was a remarkable step of the faithful of Syro Malabar Church to witness to the values of Jesus and the great enthusiasm to uphold the apostolic tradition. Migration to Gulf countries, Europe, America, South East Asia, Oceania was a growing occurrence in the modern age.

THE STORY OF SYRO MALABAR CHURCH IN IRELAND

Ireland too became one of the ideal places of shelter for those who seek good education and better job. Thus started the presence of Syro Malabar Catholics in this island of Emerald in the year 2000.

Thankfully remember all those who have wonderfully worked for the growth of this community viz., the first group of Nurses, their families, the priests and religious who came for studies and pastoral ministry and the bishops of Ireland and of India (Syro Malabar Commission for Migrants) who facilitated for the growth of Syro Malabar Church. Prayer meetings and Qurbana in the houses, later in the parish halls, were a great experience of communion and fellowship of Syro Malabar Church and ever an expression and celebration of our culture.

The Present Picture

Today we have 33 Qurbana centres having priests under the Apostolic Visitation in the whole of Ireland. Appreciatively remember all the priests and religious who have contributed to the growth of this vibrant Church and still contributing.

The whole island of Ireland is now coordinated by Msgr. Antony Perumayan, the national coordinator under the guidance and regulations of Mar Stephen Chirappanath who became the Apostolic Visitor for the Syro Malabar faithful in Europe on 1 November 2016. His presence, preaching, prayer and personal relationship with the faithful has given a great impetus to the integral growth of Syro Malabar Church in Ireland. Sincere thanks to His Beatitude Cardinal George Alencherry for his great and strenuous effort for the development of SMC in Ireland.

How can we forget all the Archbishops and bishops who gave us gentle and generous support for the development of Syro Malabar Church to its present status? It will be a great error and unforgettable mistake if we do not mention the name of Archbishop Diarmuid Martin. He was and is always like a silent sentinel who shows us the way of faith, hope and love. It is his goodwill and thoughtfulness that we are here in this Church of Rialto and we have a pastoral centre for our wide variety of ecclesial needs.

Social Responsibilities

The social commitment of the SMC communities cannot be evaded. Each Qurbana Centre has been a great helping hand for the suffering people India of which we pleased to mention one of the Recent Projects: To support Rebuild Kerala.

With the wholehearted support of all, we played an important role in supporting 40 affected families to rebuild their homes.

In the August of 2018 an unusually surplus rainy season inundated vast swathes of Kerala under water. The calamity has caused immeasurable misery and devastation. Many lives were lost. Hundreds of homes were totally destroyed and many more were damaged. For the first time in history, 35 dams in the State had to be opened. It was our duty to help the affected rebuild their lives. May the Good Lord bless you all abundantly with all His choicest blessings, for all the sacrifices you are making on behalf of Syro Malabar Catholic Church of Dublin.

Pious Associations: Syro Malabar Youth Movement, Mathruvedi, Pithruvedi (Vincent De Paul Society), Thirubalaskhyam, Mission League and different ministries of the church put their hands together for the integral growth of this Apostolic community.

We have children's retreat, youth retreat and other training programmes occasionally as part of on-going integral formation.

Coordination Councils: The Sabhayogham, The Zonal Committee, The Holy Qurbana Centres' Committees, all collaborate together for the effective outcome of the pastoral ministry.

The inauguration and blessing of the Pastoral Centre at Rialto and the initiation of the Ecclesial Ministries in the Holy Rosary Church, at Rialto will be a promising chapter in the life of Syro Malabar Church in Dublin, Ireland and the future of Catholic Church Ireland. Thankfully remember Fr. Fergal MacDonagh the Parish Priest, Mr. Robert Allen, the Parish Council Chairperson and all the officials of Rialto Holy Rosary of Our Lady of Fatima for their constant encouragement and sustained support to our community.

The Limitations and the possibilities

1. Adequate Number of priests to support each Holy Qurbana Centres: Presently we are blessed with two pastors for the 9 Holy Qurbana Centres. And with the immediate intervention of Archdiocese of Dublin one more priest will be arriving soon. Since we are going to have regular masses on Sundays and Holy days (of course in certain centres already this system has started functioning) and catechism classes the presence of priest in each mass centre will be a great boon for that faith community. The presence of a priest in each Holy Qurbana Centre for Holy Mass, Sacraments, Sacramentals, Catechism Classes, Family Units, Activities of the different catholic associations will be a great help for the respective communities. Better pastoral Care and more coordination of activities will lead to an effective outcome of the various ministries.

2. Need of Houses of Worship and Places for Imparting Faith Education: At the very outset we wish to thank the Archdiocese of Dublin which includes primarily Archbishop Diarmuid Martin, the whole curia and the different departments of the Archdiocese, the parish priests and the parish administration of all the Holy Qurbana Centres for their genuine spiritual support and generous material assistance for the whole development of the Syro Malabar Church in Dublin. Since there are regular masses on weekdays and Sundays and holidays in every Catholic Church, we are unable to have the Holy Qurbana in the regular timings on a regular basis which would be a great help for the families to plan systematically their job timings, classes and other social and familial activities. The need of catechism classrooms are a must since we have a more than 4000 children who frequent catechism classes on Sundays. Deeply appreciate the parents and catechism teachers for their profound dedication to impart faith education which they received from their ancestors. Trusting in divine providence and with all confidence we have to move ahead in search of having houses of worship in each Holy Qurbana Centre suitably accommodating the number of people and taking into

consideration the number of children for catechism classes. The support of the Archdiocese of Dublin and the genuine interest of Syro Malabar Faithful in Dublin is needed in this crucial and decisive juncture

3. Erection of Parishes and other Adequate Ecclesial Structures: As we see in England, USA and Australia and Canada, the Syro Malabar Church is flourishing in an incredible momentum at all levels. Can we aspire for such divine dreams to be actualised in the immediate future so that the variegated beauty of the Catholic Church shines forth in its diversity of particular churches? Let us pray for the better future of our church in Ireland with the intervention of the concerned authorities for the adequate provision of the ecclesial structures. Deeply appreciate the steady support given by the Irish Bishops' Conference on this august occasion.

4. The Associations and Movements In accordance with regulations of the Church.

The movements and associations as envisaged by the Syro Malabar Catholic Church respecting the universal norms of the Catholic Church have to be instituted for the smooth and effective functioning. This is one of our immediate requirements.

5. Involvement of Youth in the Ecclesial Activities: Youth are the backbone of the Church. Of course fully aware of the burdens of studies and work, we are more concerned about the integral growth of the young ones. Timely information and formation can transform their lives. We are very proud of our youth who fair very nicely in the academic and extracurricular realms. We are all the more happy if they can come together as one community witnessing the love of Jesus in the realm of prayer, care and share. We need time and space for them in our community. Their presence in the Divine worship, official bodies and charitable endeavours will make our church more efficient and effective.



6. A Need of Integration of Indian and Irish Cultures: We belong to a great tradition of East which is innately religious. We belong to a catholic tradition founded by St. Thomas, the Apostle of Jesus. We came to this land of St. Patrick with a lot of dreams and desires. This land happily accommodated us. We should be thankful to the great Irish missionaries who exported faith towards far and near. The present Ireland by their great involvement in the charitable endeavours witnesses to Jesus (DEUS CARITAS EST). We appreciate the system of education in Ireland. We are astonished at their affection and unassuming nature. We appreciate their gentlemanliness. Our response to this nation could be in the following ways

1. Being a loving presence in the place you live
2. Respecting the laws and regulations of this land and the church
3. On the occasion of main feasts, let us share our traditional Christian cultural artistic expressions with the Irish community of our vicinities
4. In the fight for Christian values let us stand together
5. For the common events of the Diocese and parish let us actively involve
6. Above all let us work together as one community based on faith and charity.
